

Actress reveals how Bharat Bhagya Viddhaata changed her view on health workers, 'Deeper sense

In a recent conversation with [BollywoodLife.com](#), Kangana shared how the film changed her perspective on hospitals and healthcare workers. She also talked about how she prepared for her role in the movie.

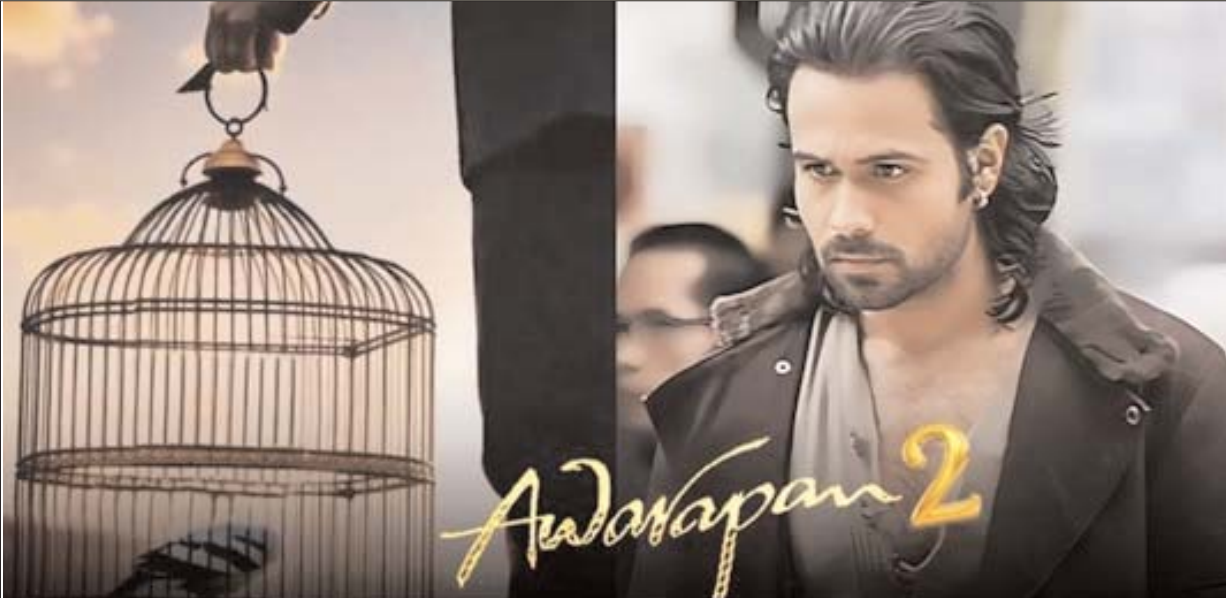
When asked if working on Bharat Bhagya Viddhaata has changed the way she looks at hospitals or healthcare workers in your everyday life, Kangana said, "Before this film, like most people, I think I took a lot of what healthcare workers do for granted. We go to a hospital, meet a doctor or a nurse, and think of it as part of a normal routine. But when you understand what these people

can be required to do in a crisis, your perspective changes completely." She continued, "A hospital is supposed to be a place where people come to feel safe, and during the 26/11 attacks, even that sense of safety was taken away. Yet the doctors, nurses and hospital staff continued to care for patients. Now whenever I see a nurse or a doctor, I have a much deeper sense of gratitude. You realise that their job requires not just professional skill but an incredible amount of emotional strength."

Kangana was also asked about how she prepped for the role of a healthcare worker and if she met or spoke to any such professionals whose stories changed her view on what bravery looks like. To that, the actress said, "Listening to the expe-

riences of healthcare professionals was very important because it takes the story away from the idea of a conventional hero. These people were not trained soldiers; they were nurses, doctors, and hospital staff who found themselves in a terrifying situation and still chose to protect their patients. These stories, in particular, stayed with me because of how instinctively they responded. The nurses was responsible for women who were pregnant and extremely vulnerable, and instead of thinking about their own safety, they thought about the patients. It made me realise that bravery is often a decision you make in a moment when you don't have the luxury of thinking too much. You simply see someone who needs help, and you step forward."

Awarapan 2 box office collection day 5: Emraan Hashmi's Awarapan 2 is showing no signs of slowing down at the box office. After enjoying a strong opening weekend, the film passed its crucial Monday test and remained steady on Tuesday as well. More importantly, the sequel has now achieved a major milestone in Emraan's career.

Released in theatres on August 14, Awarapan 2 has crossed the Rs 100 crore mark in India within just five days. This is particularly significant for Emraan, as the actor has never had a Rs 100 crore film as a solo lead before.

The original Awarapan did not make a huge impact during its theatrical run, but its emotional story and memorable music helped it develop a strong cult following over the years. The sequel, meanwhile,

has managed to turn that nostalgia into impressive box office numbers.

According to Sacnilk, the film opened with Rs 22 crore on Friday. Collections jumped by around 55% on Saturday, with the sequel earning Rs 33.75 crore. The boost came during the Independence Day weekend, with the number of shows rising from 9,033 on Friday to 10,496 on Saturday.

The film collected Rs 26 crore on Sunday, before seeing the expected post-weekend drop on Monday. However, it remained steady and earned Rs 9.25 crore on its first weekday.

Tuesday brought another slight rise. On Day 5, Awarapan 2 earned Rs 9.75 crore, taking its total domestic net collection to Rs 100.75 crore. The film's India gross collection currently stands at Rs 120

crore, while its worldwide gross has reached Rs 144.13 crore.

The Rs 100 crore milestone is a significant one for Emraan Hashmi. Although the actor has previously been part of Rs 100 crore successes such as Tiger 3 and They Call Him OG in antagonist roles, Awarapan 2 marks his first Rs 100 crore grosser as a solo lead.

The achievement is even more impressive considering the reported budget of around Rs 45 crore. With its current collections, the film has already emerged as a hit and has reportedly generated a net profit of approximately Rs 60 crore.

According to the figures, Awarapan 2 has delivered an impressive 122% return on investment in just five days, giving Emraan plenty to celebrate as the film continues its theatrical run.

Her last film, The Archies, introduced a whole new set of young actors on Net-
