Jammu Division collects Rs 56.46 lakh as fine in intensive ticket checking drive during August 2026

With the objective of creating awareness among passengers to travel with tickets and to effectively curb ticketless travel, the ticket checking drive being conducted by Jammu Division of Northern Railway collected a fine of approximately Rs. 56.46 lakh in the month of August 2026.

Under the able leadership of the Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Jammu Division, an intensive checking drive was conducted throughout the month by the ticket checking staff of the division. This drive was conducted at all important stations of the division including Jammu, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra, Shaheed Captain Tushar Mahajan, Kathua, Pathankot Cantt., Jammu Tawi, Budgam and Srinagar and in various Mail/Express and special trains passing through Jammu Division.



During this period, a total of 8106 cases were detected, which included cases like travelling without ticket, irregular travel and travelling with unbooked excess luggage. A total fine of Rs.

56,46,615 was collected from all these cases as per rules.

This drive is not limited to revenue generation only, but its main objective is to provide a safe, smooth and comfortable travel experi-

ence to railway passengers. Travelling without ticket causes inconvenience to reserved passengers and also adversely affects railway services.

On this occasion, the Senior Divisional Commercial Manager, Jammu Division said, "Jammu Division is committed to maintaining passenger convenience and railway discipline. This is the result of the dedication and continuous efforts of our ticket checking staff. Our objective is not only to take punitive action but also to make passengers aware that they must take tickets before starting their journey. Such intensive ticket checking drives will continue regularly in future as well."

Jammu Division humbly appeals to all esteemed passengers not to travel without ticket, to board the train only with a proper ticket and to cooperate with the railway administration by showing themselves as responsible passengers.

Special Conditions for EPC Mode contract (As per circular issued by Director Finance PW(R&B) Department vide No. PWD-ACCT/217/2021-05 Dated: -17-11-2023 and endorsement SE Doda No. 13076-83 Dated: -17-11-2023.
Following methodology to be adopted to facilitate hassle free procurement of contract in time bound manner on EPC Mode: -
i. The contractor shall carry out surveys and investigations and develop designs and drawings in conformity with the specifications and standards laid down in the agreement. It will get these checked by a proof consultant and a safety consultant who are to be appointed with the approval of the Government. Government's engineers should review the design and drawings to ensure that these conform to the scope of the project, design standards and specifications. The EPC agreement shall also stipulate provisions for quality control and assurance.
ii. The span and approaches of bridges as fixed by the Superintending Engineer and Executive Engineer concerned shall be final. Under no circumstances, the contracting firm shall be allowed to increase or decrease the span of the bridge while designing and vetting process.
iii. The successful bidder shall be given a time frame of 60 Days as 1st project, Milestone for submission of vetted structural design of the bridge in full.
iv. To ensure timely completion of project, the delay in achievement of 1st milestone shall attract a penalty of 0.5% per week with a maximum of 10% of component value as per payment schedule. Similarly, Penalty clauses shall be introduced for delay in achievement of any subsequent milestones as per the SBD and term and conditions of work allotment.
v. After acceptance of vetted structural design within 60 days for the issuance of LOI, the contracting firm shall have to mobilize the men and machinery at site within 15 days. Any delay on the part of contractor shall attract a penalty of 0.5% per week with a maximum of 10% of component value as per payment schedule any delay on part of Engineer would attract RDA against him/her.
vi. Achievement of each milestone shall be strictly monitored by the Superintending Engineer and Executive Engineer. Any delay in achieving the milestone without any plausible justification shall necessitate invoking penalty clause.
vii. EOT (if required) for delay in achieving each milestone shall have to be processed in due course of time with justifiable reasons by the EE/AEE concerned. No payment shall be released to the contractor for the works to be completed in a particular milestone unless EOT is not granted by the appropriate authority EOT shall be approved by SE as per justification submitted by the EE in a time bound manner.
viii. The EPC agreement shall contain the requisite provisions for dealing with force majeure events. It shall provide protection to the contractor against disciplinary actions that may have adverse effect on the timely completion of the project.
ix. In the event the Government terminates the agreement on account of any of the specified defaults of the contractor, the agreement shall allow the Government to forfeit the performance security and retention money of the contractor.
x. To have proper monitoring and supervision, day-to-day interaction between the departmental authority and the contractor must take place on regular basis. Checks and balances shall have to be provided to ensure full accountability of the contractor.
xi. The EPC contract agreement shall be as per the standard format issued by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways for National Highways and centrally sponsored Schemes.
xii. The EPC contractor shall submit a final quality check certificate of bridge construction/completion from DIQC J&K before handing it over to the user department which may be incorporated in the agreement.

Terms of payment (in respect of Bridges)
i. Two percent of total allotted cost when the complete vetted drawings & Design of all components of the foot bridge (sub-structure, super structure, approach wall and protection works) is submitted in both soft and hard format to the Department by the Firm
ii. Thirty percent of the total allotted cost when abutments, wing wall & return walls stand completed and verified by the AEE & JE at site,
iii. Thirty percent of the total allotted cost when fabricated material is verified by AEE & JE at site.
iv. Eighteen percent of the total allotted cost after fixing of chequered plate, abutments caps, Dirt wall & performing successful load test as per IRC guidelines.
v. Balance after completion of job in all respects. However, ten percent shall be kept as security deposit from running bill which shall be released after successful completion of defect liability period of five years after completion of the bridge.
