Addressing the participants, Sh. Jodh Raj Bhagat, Chief Executive Officer, Municipal Council Samba, appreciated the initiative taken by BIS in organizing the awareness programme. He emphasized that such awareness programmes should be organized more frequently, especially for students of Government schools and common consumers, to create greater awareness about quality standards, product safety, and consumer protection.

The DC directed the BRO authorities to complete the ongoing clearance works within three days. He stressed the need for expediting the removal of the identified structures to facilitate the timely execution of the highway project.
