5. The bids of the work shall remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids and the tender shall be applicable for the financial year 2026-27.

6. Quantities of work may increase or decrease. The contractor will have to execute the work as per site conditions / specifications as per the directions of the site Engineer. Any item not covered in the BOQ shall be paid at par **SSR 2022** or the rate quoted by the contractor whichever is less.

7. Earnest Money received by the Department, as CDR/ FDR shall be released in favour of the unsuccessful bidders after the allotment to the successful bidder and no request by any bidder shall be entertained prior to allotment of individual work.

8. In case the work is not started within the time stipulated for start of work, the work will automatically be treated as cancelled and no correspondence shall be made for the same and CDR will be forfeited without intimation. However, in case the Contractor applies for the grace period before the date of start of the Contract on valid grounds supported with documents his request for the grace period will be considered for one time only.
