

Elnaaz Norouzi set for first Hollywood lead as 'The Fix' nears the US theatrical release



With *The Fix* only days away from its theatrical release, Elnaaz Norouzi is stepping into a significant new chapter in her international career. The actress takes on her first leading role in a Hollywood film, starring as Zara alongside Liam Neeson and Zachary Levi in Guy Moshe's action thriller, arriving in the USA theatres on September 11.

For Elnaaz, who has built a career across India and international projects, *The Fix* marks a very

different kind of milestone. Zara isn't simply a character passing through the story. She becomes increasingly central as the film unfolds, with her choices ultimately playing a crucial role in where the story goes.

Zara is introduced as an Iranian-born, American-raised college student who finds herself posing as Tucker's wife as he navigates a dangerous mission in Iran. What begins as an arrangement soon becomes more complicated, as the relationship between Zara and Tucker develops and the stakes around them continue to rise.

The role also carries a particularly personal connection for Elnaaz. Born in Tehran herself, she speaks both Farsi and English in the film and brought an innate understanding of Iran and its culture to the character. Interestingly, however, playing Zara required her to put much of her own experience.

The actress has previously spoken about having to approach Zara without judgment and understand why the character thinks, believes and behaves the way she does — something that required extensive research, reading and preparation, along with working on an American accent for the role.

For an actress who first became widely known in India through *Sacred Games* and has since continued building a career across markets, *The Fix* represents more than another international credit. It is the first time audiences will see Elnaaz step into a leading role in a Hollywood film.

With Liam Neeson and Zachary Levi leading the high-stakes thriller alongside her, September 11 could mark an important new chapter in Elnaaz Norouzi's Hollywood journey.

The Fix releases in the US theatres on September 11.

Neha was equally forthcoming about her own contribution to the format. "Ye fame isliye gir gaya kyunki maine karna chhod diya. Jab tak main kar rahi thi, TRPs highest thi," she said, suggesting the shows declined only after she stepped away.

On the question of scripting, she was firm. "These shows aren't scripted at all. People's lives aren't scripted either.

If I feel emotions upon hearing someone's story, that feeling is natural," she said, adding that contestants who have fought their way from small towns to the national stage are not going to fabricate their struggles.

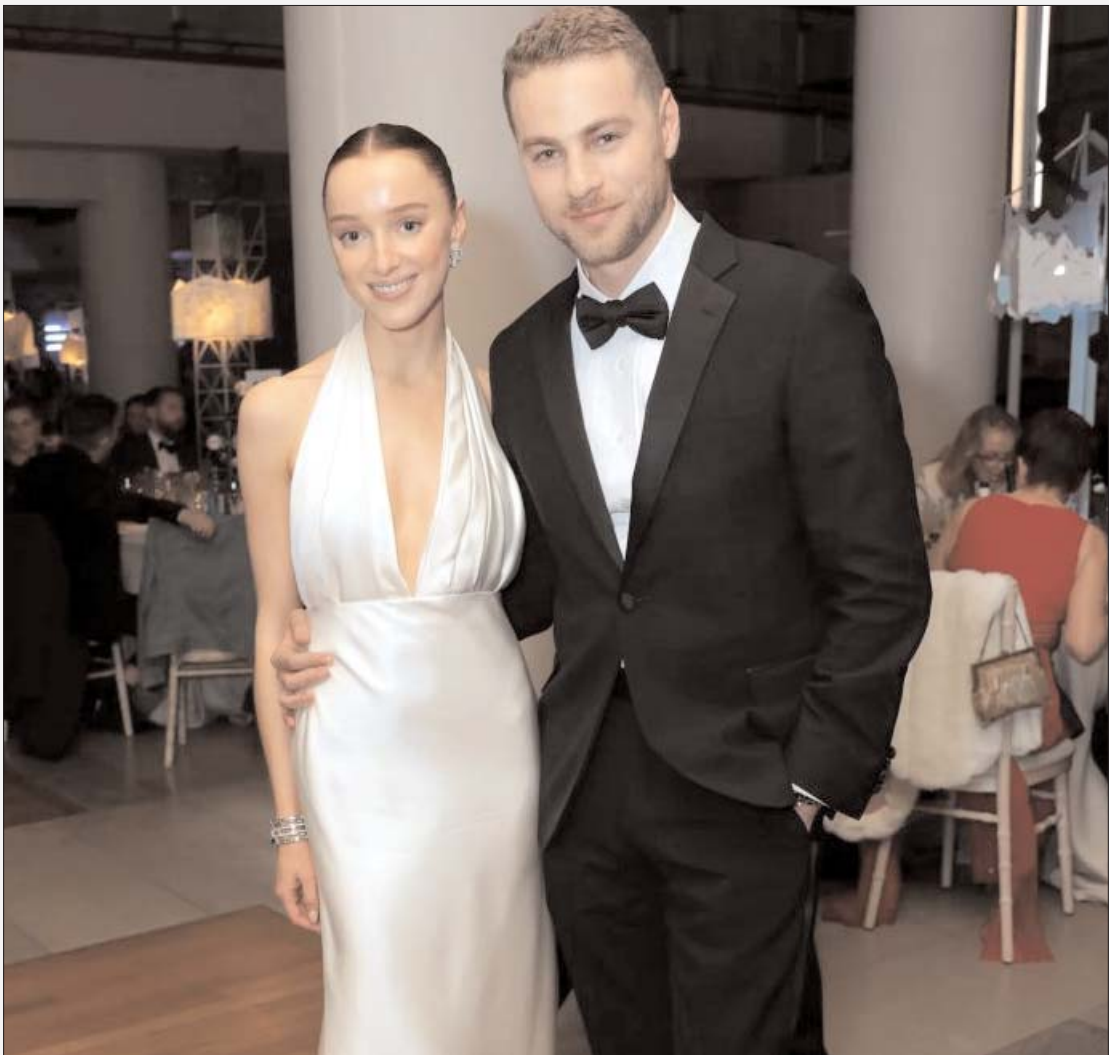
Bridgerton star Phoebe Dynevor marries Cameron Fuller in the French countryside

Phoebe Dynevor did not announce her wedding. She just had one.

The *Bridgerton* actress, 31, married film producer Cameron Fuller, 30, on September 5 at Le Mas des Poiriers, a 65-acre estate on an island in the Rhone River near Avignon. The 18th-century farmhouse, which Dynevor had visited with Fuller last year and fallen in love with, hosted an intimate ceremony followed by a sit-down dinner, drinks and dancing into the evening. Only family and close friends were present, including her mother Sally Dynevor and sister Hattie.

The signs had been there for months. At Paris Fashion Week earlier this year, Dynevor wore a draped white Louis Vuitton ensemble and told reporters it was "a little nod to the year of my wedding." In August, she celebrated her hen party in London before quietly making her way to France.

Their story began at the Sundance Film Festival in January 2023, where Dynevor was promoting *Fair Play*. The two went public at Wimbledon that July. Fuller, son of Hollywood producer Brad Fuller, proposed during a family holiday in the Cotswolds in May 2024. Dynevor's sister later recalled that she was "crying her eyes out" when he did.

Ranveer and Deepika married in November 2018 in an intimate ceremony at Lake Como, Italy, after six years of dating.

On the work front, Deepika is filming *King* alongside Shah Rukh Khan, releasing December 24, and has Atlee's *Raaka* with Allu Arjun in development. Ranveer is currently shooting for *Pralay*.
