

ADDC Samba reviews District Capex 2026-27, JK Samadhan Registrations

SAMBA, SEPTEMBER 11: Additional District Development Commissioner (ADDC) Samba Champa Devi today chaired a meeting to review the progress achieved under the District Capex Budget 2026-27 and the status of registrations and grievances redressal on the JK Samadhan Portal.



The ADC exhorted the Block Development Officers (BDOs) and Rural Engineering Wing (REW) to

pull out all the stops in expediting the tendering process and ensuring the early allotment of works, thereby laying the groundwork for their timely execution.

Giving a detailed account of the progress, the Assistant Commissioner Development (ACD) Rafiq Ahmad Jaral informed the meeting that nearly 90 per cent progress has already been achieved in the allotment process and identification of L1 bidders. He assured that the process would be brought to fruition to the tune of 98 per cent by September 15, 2026.

The ADC directed the executing agencies to nip bottlenecks in the bud, adopt a proactive approach and ensure that all sanctioned works are completed within the stipulated timelines.

She underscored that implementation must remain on an even keel and that there should be no let-up in the pace of execution, in accordance with the directions of Deputy Commissioner Samba Ayushi Sudan.

DDC Bandipora reviews progress under District Capex, Revenue Capex Budgets

District Development Commissioner (DDC) Bandipora, Indu Kanwal Chib, today chaired a meeting at the Mini Secretariat to review the physical and financial progress under the District Capex and Revenue Capex Budgets for 2026-27.

The meeting was attended by Superintending Engineers of PHE Hydraulic Circle, R&B Circle and KPDCL, Divisional Forest Officer, Assistant Commissioner Development, Assistant Commissioner Panchayat, Executive Engineers and other concerned district sector officers.

During the meeting, the DDC reviewed progress on 2,056 developmental works under the District Capex Budget against an approved outlay of Rs 4,527.26 lakh. These include 120 ongoing and 1,935 new works. It was informed that Administrative Approval has been accorded to 1,807 works,



1,350 have been tendered, 889 allotted and 68 works have been completed.

The DDC directed the General Manager, NHPC, to expedite approval and disbursement of Rs 8.50 crore earmarked for the affected areas of the Kis-hanganga Hydroelectric Project under the Water Conservation Plan. The Chief Agriculture Officer was also directed to expedite all pending works under the conservation framework.

The meeting also re-

viewed 24 departmental buildings being taken up under the Revenue Capex Budget. The executing agencies were directed to expedite the construction works and ensure timely submission of completed bills to the respective treasuries.

The DFO Bandipora was directed to complete the billing process for works worth Rs 75.50 lakh under SSY and submit the bills to the treasury within five days. The Executive Engineer, Hydraulic Gurez, was

asked to raise the pending bill of Rs 1.06 lakh under District Capex without delay. The Executive Engineer, R&B Gurez, was directed to complete the restoration work of Habba Khatoon Spring by October 20.

The DDC also directed the concerned BDOs to finalize procurement of items under DDC and BDC grants at the earliest and refer cases to the District Procurement Committee wherever required to avoid procedural delays.

Symposium on Road Safety held at GHSS Boys Rajouri

Traffic Police Rural Jammu, in collaboration with Government Model Boys Higher Secondary School Rajouri today organized a symposium on the topic "Right to mobility comes with the responsibility to follow Traffic rules," here at the school premises.

The event formed part of ongoing 02-week Awareness -cum-Enforcement Drive against traffic violations involving two-wheelers. As many as 600 students and 60 teachers participated in the programme.

At the outset, the Principal of the School Mohammad Muslim Wani welcomed the SSP and other guests. The stage proceedings were conducted by Sr. Lecturer Fazal Hussain.

Dy-SP Traffic Rajouri-Poonch Ajaz Ahmed highlighted the broad idea behind holding the drive, which he said was to generate awareness about road safety, promote responsible road-user behaviour and foster a strong sense of responsibility towards preventing road accidents and saving lives among students and the community. He urged the students to become ambassadors of road safety and contribute



actively towards creating safer roads and communities.

Interacting with the students, the SSP discussed the prevailing scenario of road accidents and their major causes. He emphasized the importance of observing traffic rules, re-

sponsible driving and developing a strong sense of civic responsibility among young people. He gave a Power Point Presentation, protecting the local accident data which formed the basis for initiating this drive.

As per the presentation,

699 accidents have taken place between January to July, 2026 in the four Districts of Rajouri, Poonch, Samba and Kathua in which 88 persons were killed and 1001 were injured. However, an alarming trend is the fact that out of 699 accidents, 309 i.e. 44% are those in which two-wheelers are involved. Further, out of 88 dead, 39 are those who were either driving or riding a two-wheeler. Moreover, 27% of the victims are below 25 years of age.

The SSP also shared a personal connection with the institution, being an alumnus of Government Model Boys Higher Secondary School Rajouri. Recalling his association with the school, he said that returning to his alma mater in the capacity of SSP Traffic Rural Jammu was a matter of pride and added significance to the road-safety awareness initiative. He encouraged the students to uphold the values of discipline and responsibility associated with their institution and to become ambassadors of road safety in their families and communities.

The symposium was judged by a panel comprising Uma Gupta (Sr. Lecturer), Subash Sharma (Sr. Lecturer) and Amir Choudhary (Physical Education Lecturer), who evaluated the performances of the participating students.
