

Ameesha Patel's Mumbai home robbed, domestic help arrested over Rs 5 lakh jewellery theft



Mumbai Police have taken a domestic worker into custody over the alleged theft of jewellery worth around Rs 5 lakh from the Churchgate residence of actor Ameesha Patel's family.

The accused, identified as 40-year-old Seema Ghate, had been working at the home of Patel's mother, Asha Patel, for close to eighteen months before her arrest.

Investigators say a diamond-studded gold bangle disappeared from the residence in January 2026. Asha Patel had reportedly suspected Ghate early on and spent several months urging her to return the missing item before eventually approaching the police.

The complaint was filed. A crime detection unit tracked Ghate down in Virar, where she was arrested and later produced in court. She has been remanded to police custody until September 15.

The stolen bangle has not yet been recovered, and police are separately checking whether Ghate has any prior criminal history or worked with others in the alleged theft.

Neither Ameesha Patel nor her family has issued a personal statement on the matter so far.

Patel began her acting career in 2000 opposite Hrithik Roshan in *Kaho Naa... Pyaar Hai* and went on to headline hits including *Gadar: Ek Prem Katha* and *Race 2*. She was last seen on screen in 2024's *Tauba Tera Jalwa*.

Rohit Roy calls television a 'dustbin medium'

Visibility, in his view, isn't the same as respect. "They are never going to respect you because what are you doing? You are not really doing anything," he said, adding



that most TV actors struggle to communicate well with their audience. Roy's own career began on the small screen, with his 1995 *Door-darshan* debut in *Swabhimaan*, followed by shows including *Kkusum* and *Des Mein Nikla Hoga Chand*. He has since crossed into films such as *Kaabil*, *Fashion* and *Shootout at Lokhandwala*, and was most recently seen in the 2025 thriller *Control*.

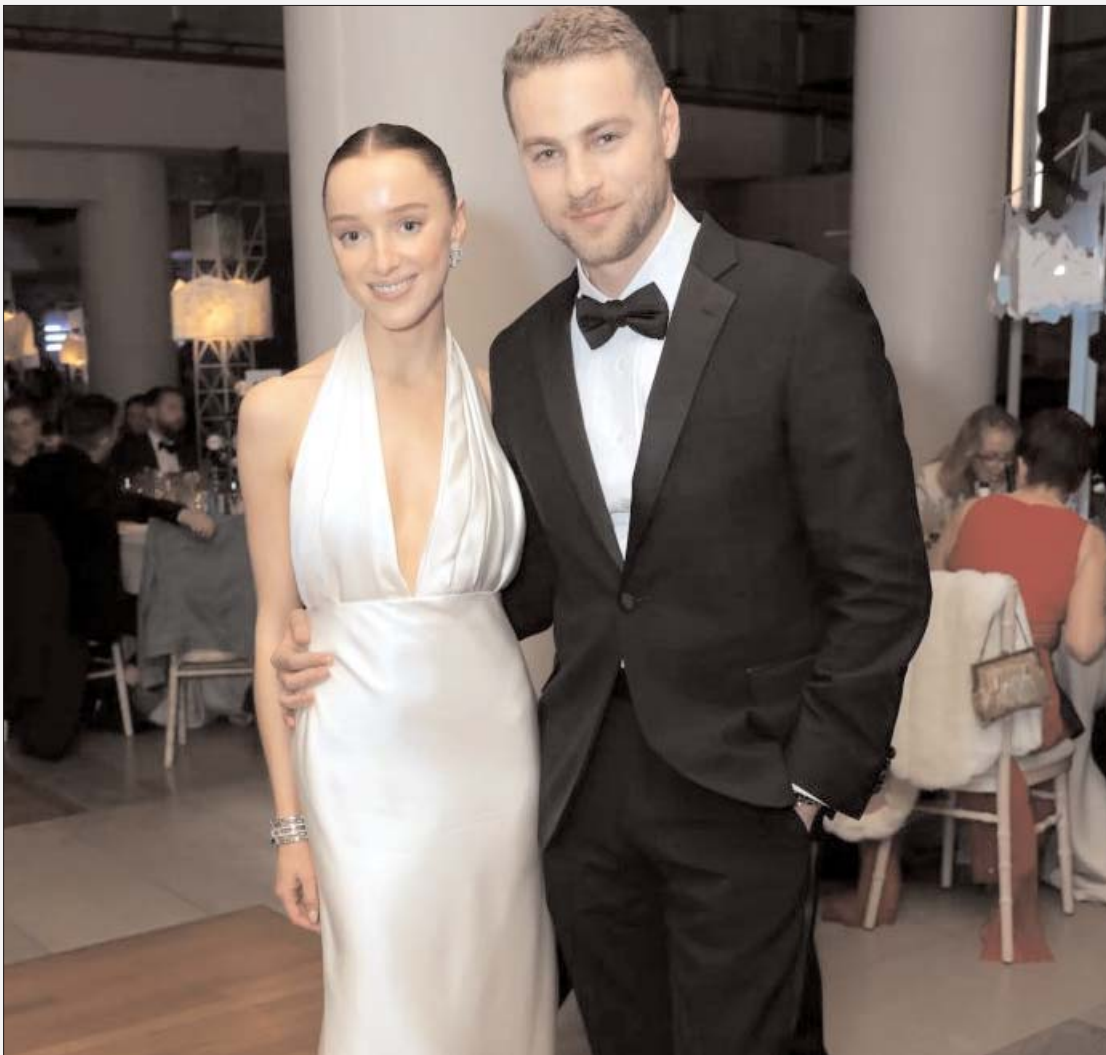
Bridgerton star Phoebe Dynevor marries Cameron Fuller in the French countryside

Phoebe Dynevor did not announce her wedding. She just had one.

The *Bridgerton* actress, 31, married film producer Cameron Fuller, 30, on September 5 at Le Mas des Poiriers, a 65-acre estate on an island in the Rhone River near Avignon. The 18th-century farmhouse, which Dynevor had visited with Fuller last year and fallen in love with, hosted an intimate ceremony followed by a sit-down dinner, drinks and dancing into the evening. Only family and close friends were present, including her mother Sally Dynevor and sister Hattie.

The signs had been there for months. At Paris Fashion Week earlier this year, Dynevor wore a draped white Louis Vuitton ensemble and told reporters it was "a little nod to the year of my wedding." In August, she celebrated her hen party in London before quietly making her way to France.

Their story began at the Sundance Film Festival in January 2023, where Dynevor was promoting *Fair Play*. The two went public at Wimbledon that July. Fuller, son of Hollywood producer Brad Fuller, proposed during a family holiday in the Cotswolds in May 2024. Dynevor's sister later recalled that she was "crying her eyes out" when he did.
