DJSES Trains Accountants, Principals on Revised EPF Wage Ceiling

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The Diocesan Education Board (DEB) of the Diocese of Jammu-Srinagar Education Society (DJSES) has conducted a dedicated training programme for accountants and principals of its

schools across Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh in preparation for the revised statutory EPF wage ceiling.

The Government of India has revised the EPF wage ceiling from ₹15,000 to ₹25,000 per month with effect from September 17, 2026, requiring schools to make necessary

changes in payroll and statutory contribution calculations.

As part of the preparatory exercise, DJSES issued a circular to all its schools explaining the revised ceiling and its effective date. The Society also developed a September 2026 PF-ESI-CTC Calculator in Excel to facilitate

accurate, prorated calculations during the transition period.

The training webinar covered the September split-period calculation, use of the calculator, preparation of the Electronic Challan-cum-Return (ECR) and treatment of Provident Fund and Pension Scheme contributions. Special attention was given to employees newly covered under PF due to the revised wage ceiling.

The Society also held consultations with the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner (RPFC) to seek clarity on implementation-related issues ahead of the September filing.

Chairman of the Diocesan Education Board, Fr. Shaiju Chacko, said the priority was to ensure that employees' contributions were calculated correctly and that school accounts teams were adequately prepared for the transition.

With the September ECR due for filing by October 15, DJSES said it would continue guiding its schools on the revised provisions and ensure uniform implementation across their ERP systems.

DC Ramban reviews Anti-Narcotics measures

RAMBAN, SEPTEMBER 29: Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Mohammad Alyas Khan, today chaired the District-Level Narco Coordination Centre (NCORD) Committee meeting to review anti-narcotics measures to curb drug abuse in the district.

The meeting was attended by Additional Deputy Commissioner Varunjeet Singh Charak; Addl. SP Majeed-ur-Rehman; Medical Superintendent DH, Executive Engineer PWD, Chief Education Officer, Chief Horticulture Officer, Drug Control Officer and officers from the enforcement and line departments. Officers stationed outside the district attended the meeting virtually.

Reviewing the implementation of directions issued at the previous NCORD meeting, the DC directed the Drug Inspector to intensify enforcement drives in coordination with the concerned Tehsildars and Police Department against the illegal sale and misuse of scheduled drugs.
